中華民國與獅子山技術合作協定

AGREEMENT OF TECHNICAL COOPERATION BETWEEN
THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND SIERRA LEONE

Signed on March 20, 1964;

Entered into force on March 20, 1964.

The Government of the Republic of China and the Government of Sierra Leone, being desirous of further promoting the friendly relations happily existing between them, have agreed through their respective representatives upon the following articles:

ARTICLE I

The Chinese Government shall send to Sierra Leone a Farming Demonstration Team, composed of one leader, a deputy and 8 to 10 Members to carry out general farming particularly rice growing for two years in an area in the Port Loko District in the Northern Province of Sierra Leone on an experimental and demonstration basis.

ARTICLE II

The Chinese Government shall defray the travelling cost of the Team to and from Sierra Leone.

ARTICLE III

The Chinese Government shall pay the salaries to the Team during their period of

services in Sierra Leone.

ARTICLE IV

The Team shall enjoy equal treatment as accorded by the Government of Sierra Leone to the nationals of third countries serving in Sierra Leone in connection with technical cooperation projects between those countries and Sierra Leone.

ARTICLE V

The Team shall have free use of the land in the demonstration area for the purpose as provided in Article I.

The Team shall turn over to the Government of Sierra Leone all products from the land in this demonstration area except a reasonable part thereof to be kept for the Team's own consumption.

ARTICLE VI

The Government of Sierra Leone shall undertake land clearing and land preparation and construction of necessary water supply

and irrigation and drainage system.

ARTICLE VII

The Government of Sierra Leone shall provide the Team with houses furnished with water, electricity, furniture, beddings, stoves, refrigerators and utensils. The Leader of the Team shall occupy at least one room; not more than two Members shall so far as may be reasonably practical occupy one room.

ARTICLE VIII

The Government of Sierra Leone shall provide farming implements and tools as specified in the Annex together with two auto vehicles including fuel supply, maintenance and repair.

The Government of Sierra Leone shall provide fertilizers, seeds and pesticides as specified in the Annex.

ARTICLE IX

The Government of Sierra Leone shall defray all medical expenses incurred by the Team in agreement with it.

The Government of Sierra Leone shall designate a Liaison Officer to reside near the living quarters of the Team in order to provide such assistance as is requested.

ARTICLE X

The parties to this Agreement shall effectuate its provisions by exerting every effort to accomplish the attached Schedule of Implementation.
