The commitee should be comprised of personnel assigned by both parties to work alternately in Taiwan and in the State of Hamburg in Germany for suitable periods to enhance the cooperative relationship and technical interchange.

7. Both parties are fully aware of the fact that any decision made by residents and companies of the parivate sector from both sides in favour of the said facilities mentioned above is exclusively the result of a private business initiative, and IDIC and HWF do not take any legal responsibility in this regard.
