



## **DECISION NO. 18**

Modification of the Raw and Refined Sugar Limit Quota of Annex 3.04 of the Free Trade Agreement between the Republic of China (Taiwan), the Republic of El Salvador and the Republic of Honduras

The Administrative Commission of the Free Trade Agreement between the Republic of China (Taiwan), the Republic of El Salvador and the Republic of Honduras ("the Agreement"), pursuant to its powers and according to what is established in Article 14.01 (2) (c) and (3) (e) of the Agreement,

## **DECIDES:**

To modify Annex 3.04 (2) (b) (c) "Tariff Reduction Schedule" in respect to the Tariff Treatment of the Republic of China (Taiwan) to increase the total tariff-free annual quota to 70,000 metric tons of raw and refined sugar originating from the Republic of Honduras, inclusive of an upper limit of 55,000 metric tons of raw sugar, and 15,000 metric tons of refined sugar to be exported from the Republic of Honduras to the Republic of China (Taiwan). The Republic of Honduras will handle the quota allotment for the raw and refined sugar which will be granted entry into the Republic of China (Taiwan) free of customs duties upon receipt by Customs of the Republic of China (Taiwan) of a Certificate of Origin and a Certificate of Quota issued by the competent government body of the Republic of Honduras.
